

# Get Help Paying for Insulin Medication – With Just One Phone Call!

Are you having trouble paying for the high cost of your insulin?

## Here's Help!

The American Diabetes Association (ADA) has developed a program that is available to **anyone struggling to pay for insulin medication**.

### Here's how the ADA's program works

1. Determine your insulin manufacturer by checking the company logo on your insulin vial or pen.
2. Call the hotline phone number below of the manufacturer of your insulin.

A customer service representative will confirm your eligibility and explain your options.

### Before you call

Plan to spend 20 to 30 minutes on the call and be prepared to provide:

- Basic contact information
- Date of birth
- Income
- Confirm whether or not you have an active prescription at a pharmacy
- Your cost of insulin for a monthly supply
- What is your method of insulin administration – vial or pen
- Your current dosage
- How much insulin you have on hand
- Type of insurance you have (private, commercial)
- If you have insurance, the amount of your deductible
- Whether you are a U.S. resident (required)
